About JPC-SED (from our Japan Office)

They are an NPO and an NGO and is an organisation created by the merger

of 2 organisations which each had been established to enhance economic

development of postwar Japan through productivity and by address issues

such as welfare, energy and environment. Have approx 2,000 member companies, labour unions etc and have 300 staff.

Committee members include well known individuals from the utilities and

other major companies.

Breakdown of their business: 80% of their work involves arranging management training courses, seminars etc. 15% is work undertaking research/request from government organisations. 5% is miscellaneous work.

The study mission to Europe is an annual event, this year being the 14th. (Last year they went to France and Spain, they went to UK 4-5 years ago but BNFL were not approached - probably as it was after

MDF)

Japan Atomic Energy Research Institute (JAERI) with whom we have had successful staff exchanges in the past, tend to take a lead on these energy study missions. It had actually been someone in JAERI's personnel division that had requested/suggested a visit to BNFL on the

programme. Half of last year's attendees were from JAERI, the rest were

staff who are to become operations managers within their respective companies.

staff training programme).
