### **Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I write in reply to your email to me of 14 December.

Might I first say that my understanding is that your dissatisfaction with UCL's response to your request relates to the matter of correspondence with Mr. Oakes.

I have reviewed the relevant available information and the email correspondence between yourself and our Freedom of Information Officer. I am satisfied overall that UCL has complied with its obligations under the Act but that there is however some information contained in a letter from UCL to Mr. Oakes which should not, in my view, be exempted. I therefore set out below the information in question.

UCL wrote to Mr Oakes on 17 September regarding information on websites in which there was stated to be a link between Mr. Oakes and UCL.

In UCL's letter, Mr Oakes is told that UCL has "found no records of either the Group [the Behavioural Dynamics Working Group] or confirmation that [Mr. Oakes] studied psychology at UCL".


UCL asked Mr Oakes

- a) what was the period of [his] study [at UCL] and whom did [he] set up the Behavioural Studies Working Group with" and
- b) "if [he] did not study at UCL [to] please confirm that [he] will amend the SCL Website".

The letter of 17 September 2007 is UCL's only communication with Mr. Oakes and no communication has to this date been received from him.

Should you continue to be dissatisfied with UCL's response to your request, you may apply to the Information Commissioner for a decision about whether your request has been dealt with by UCL in accordance with the requirements of the Act.
